Its headquarters are in Rochester and satellite offices are located in Geneva and Corning, New York, and a policy office in Albany.

CDR was chosen based on the company's dedication and commitment to the current and future workforce. CDR has shown dedication to the future workforce by posting positions with RochesterWorks! and representatives from CDR participated in Recruiting Round Rochester events, the First Annual Career Conference and will be participating in the Regional Career Conference where they provided information about careers at CDR.
