

East Rochester Youth Training and Employment Program



Our WIA program works with youth 14-21 years of age. Program participants will have an opportunity to receive tutoring, explore career possibilities, receive job readiness training and have a work experience for about 120 hours. Work sites will be assigned according to participants interests and availability. The objective of the program is to increase basic skills and provide structured employment.

The following opportunities are available through this program:

- **Tutoring:** at school or at the Center
- **Job skills workshops:** Including resume writing, applications completion, and work ethic
- **Career Exploration:** indentifying career goals, and applicable courses and training
- **Job Shadowing**
- **Work Experience:** participants can work about 120 hours.
