School to work is a program that will focus on introducing in-school students to the employment world, at the same time learning the basic life skills needed after graduation. The purpose of the program is to provide the student with pre-vocational skills including interviewing, career exploration, job development, and resume building. Other activities will include socialization, financial planning and post-education options. While in the program students will participate in group discussions as well as 1 on 1 vocational counseling. The students are graded on effort, participation and attendance. The students that have done well can then focus on the 10-week internship at the local business of their choice. The internship can begin before the school year ends or during the summer.
