## Electro-Mechanical Technician(s)

**Description:** The plant maintenance team provides **electro-mechanical** support for production machines and equipment. The team is dedicated to keeping production moving with minimal downtime by troubleshooting and repairing equipment issues. This includes resolving mechanical and electrical problems and performing scheduled maintenance on equipment. This position entails working as a member of a team to perform and document troubleshooting, repairs, and preventative maintenance of high speed manufacturing, injection molding, packaging, and sterilizing equipment. Other aspects may include project work, offline rebuild work as well as training other technicians.

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor the **Electro-Mechanical Technician** will be responsible for the following:

- Work on a maintenance team alongside operations technicians and engineers in a cross-functional team setting to minimize machine downtime and improve line output.
- Troubleshoot, repair, and properly document machine issues.
- Troubleshoot / diagnose PLC/HMI control systems software when possible.
- Perform and document preventative maintenance as required.
- Communicate machine issues/downtime to other shifts as well as supervisor/management.
- Assist with any offline machine rebuilds or prep work.
- Ability to work Bausch + Lomb twelve-hour rotational shift schedule is required:
- Rotation is M/T - 6AM-6PM, W/Th - off, F/S/Su - 6PM-6AM, M/T - off, W/Th - 6AM-6PM, F/S/Su - off, two-week pattern repeats but opposite day/nights.
- Minimal travel to support equipment build/integration and/or training may be required.
- Support of plant manufacturing equipment systems under the direction of the plant Maintenance Supervisor.

**Education:** HS diploma required. Technical apprenticeship or Associates degree in related electrical or mechanical field preferred but job experience may be substituted for degree requirement

**Specialized Skills:** Knowledge of steam sterilizers and PLC code. Experience with laboratory instrumentation and calibration preferred. Knowledge of OSHA (Occupational Safety & Health Act) requirements, basic computer skills (Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook) preferred.

**Experience:** Minimum 5 years in technician role supporting sterilization equipment. Electro-mechanical technician experience with high speed automation preferred. Medical device or other FDA regulated industry beneficial. Strong analytical and troubleshooting skills are required. Attention to detail, excellent communication skills and ability to work in a team environment are essential. Understanding of steam sterilizers, PLC code, engineering drawings, problem solving and troubleshooting.
