JOB DESCRIPTION

General Laborer:

- Experience with jobsite labor
- Must be able to help carpenters, roofers, masons, etc.
- Tools of the trade (tool belt)
- Ability to take initiative on jobsite
- OSHA a plus
- Reliable transportation

HVAC/R Technician:

- Studying building plans and working drawings to determine work aids required and sequence of installations
- Diagnosing causes of equipment breakdowns, testing parts with appropriate instruments, disassembling and assembling parts, and making necessary repairs
- Locating and marking position of pipe and/or duct connections and passage holes for same in walls and floors and then cutting openings to accommodate pipe and/or duct fittings, using hand tools and power tools
- Cutting and threading pipe, using pipe cutters, cutting torch, and pipe-threading machine
- Reliable transportation
- OSHA a plus

Metal Stud Framer:

- Must have experience and tools for metal stud framing
- Good work ethic
- Reliable transportation
- OSHA a plus

Millwright:

- Installing, maintaining, and repairing machinery and equipment according to layout plans, blue prints, and other drawings in an industrial establishment
- Constructing the foundation for machines and equipment using hand tools and building materials such as wood, cement, and steel
- Operating engine lathe to grind, file, and turn machine parts to dimensional specifications and may at times lubricate the machines and equipment

Painter:

- Filling nail holes, cracks, and joints with putty plaster
- Smoothing surfaces, using sandpaper, brushes, or steel wool
- Removing old paint from surfaces using paint remover, scraper, wire brush, or blowtorch to prepare surfaces for painting
- Painting surfaces using brushes, spray gun, or paint rollers
- Simulating wood grain, marble, brick, tile or other special effects with cloth, brush, or sponge
- Erecting scaffolding or setting up ladders safely to perform tasks above ground level

JOB DESCRIPTION

Pipefitter:

- Selecting type and size of pipe and related materials according to job specifications, knowledge of system operation, and study of building plans / working drawings
- Planning sequence of installation to avoid obstructions and cutting pipe
- Threading and ending pipe by hand or with pipe bending machine
- Assembling and joining piping by means of threaded, chalked, wiped, soldered, brazed fused, or cemented joints
- Securing pipes to structure with clamps, brackets, and hangers, using hand tools
- Testing piping systems for leaks by increasing pressure in pipes and observing gauges

Plumber:

- Inspecting structure, locating and marking positions of pipes, connections, and passage holes for pipe in walls and floors
- Cutting openings in walls and floors to accommodate pipe and pipe fittings
- Cutting, threading, and bending pipe to required angles
- Assembling and installing valves, pipe fittings, and pipes composed of metals and non-metals
- Joining pipes by use of screws, bolts, fittings, and solder
- Testing pipes by filling them with water or air and reads gauges to determine whether system is working accurately
- Installing and repairing plumbing fixtures
- Repairing and maintaining plumbing by replacing washers in leaky faucets, mending burst pipes, and opening clogged drains

Rofer:

- Inspecting problem roofing to determine the best repair procedures
- Working on low-slope or steep-slope roofs sometimes both
- Covering roofs and exterior walls of structures with slate, asphalt, aluminum, wood, gravel, gypsum, and/or related materials, using brushes, knives, punches, hammers, and other tools
- Installing vapor barriers and/or layers of insulation on the roof decks of flat roofs, and sealing the seams
- Removing snow, water, or debris from roofs prior to applying roofing materials
- Cutting felt, shingles, or strips of flashing to fit angles formed by walls, vents, or intersecting roof surfaces

Septic Tank Technician:

Experience:

- A minimum of two years' commercial truck driving experience is required.
- Septic tank cleaning experience is preferred.

License/Certification:

- Must have and maintain a valid CDL-B (or A) driver's license.
- Must have or obtain Tanker Endorsement prior to starting work.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Test Technician:

- Consolidated experience in testing and troubleshooting of electrical/electronic equipment
- Technical education is appreciated but can be replaced with more experience on the field
- Ability to read electrical and electronics drawings/schematics
- Ability to use test instruments, especially multi-meters, meggers and hi-pot machines
- Competent with use of computers and MS Excel in particular
- Ability to work safely on live circuits (40VDC, 230VAC and 650VDC)
- Ability to execute electrical and basic mechanical jobs (mostly repairs under warranty)
- Mandatory availability to work night shift. This will happen during burn-in period only, usually 1-2 weeks every 3-4 months
- Mandatory availability to do overtime

Vinyl Sider:

- Minimum 1 year experience with vinyl siding
- Tools of the trade required including tool belt
- Fit and fasten siding material to laths, using rule, measuring tape, hand tools, power tools, nails, screws, or bolts
- Cut and trim material to shape when fitting siding around windows or corners, using knife, shears, or portable power saw
- Waterproof surface by filling joints or cracks with caulking compound, using putty knife, trowel, or caulking gun
- Cut siding to size and shape at work site
- Attach siding by interlocking pieces through tabs provided at edges, following sequence indicated by numbers printed on reverse of each piece
- Efficiently follow work orders and safely use all tools
- OSHA a plus

Wood Framer:

Responsibilities:

- Framing with wood studs
- Precisely measure, cut and assemble the framing material needed to build residential, commercial or industrial buildings
- Work on new construction, remodels or additions to existing structures
- Read and follow blue prints
- Possibly build scaffolds, frame interior walls or construct forms into which concrete is poured

Requirements:

- Must be able to lift and carry heavy objects, such as lumber, sheets of plywood and other building material
- Must also understand math functions and calculations involving fractions
- **Must have valid driver's license**
- Reliable transportation that is not public transportation
- OSHA is a plus
